Bill is a firm believer in strengthening community ties and assisting local children programs: in particular, providing care, comfort and much-needed resources for the young patients at All Children's Hospital; and through the Edwards Family Foundation providing community-minded outreach. proud Treasure Island resident, he acquired The Club at Treasure Island in July of 2009, determined to build the local landmark into West Central Florida's social epicenter and cultural nerve center.

HARRY BLACK, Director/2nd Vice Chair · Island Inn

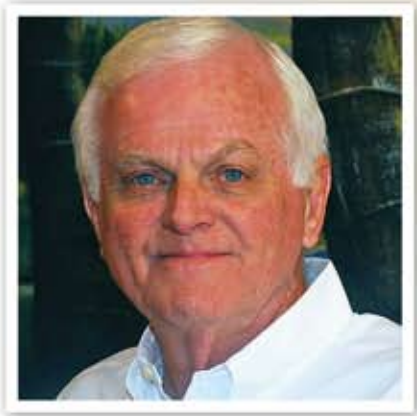
